**Bango Wind Farm**

We are in receipt of your letters dated 17<sup>th</sup> August and 5<sup>th</sup> November 2012, and comment as follows.

As we now have a clearer understanding of the extent and scale of the Bango Wind Farm (as provided in the 05.11.12 correspondence – locality map & photomontages) we are vehemently opposed to such a development within such close proximity to our residence, and any other adjoining residences in the locale. Accordingly, we reject your proposed Neighbour Agreement “to allow turbines to be placed within 2 km of the [REDACTED], as stated in your August letter.


Whilst we are not opposed to the efforts to harness renewable energy, we are entirely opposed to the nominated locations for the proposed turbines.

As discussed in our phone conversation in August 2012, the primary reason for buying into a rural property was to escape from ‘built up areas’ and associated infrastructure, and to immerse ourselves and our family in the natural & tranquil environment which [REDACTED] and the surrounding Yass Valley provides.

The detailed topographic map identifying the specific turbine locations and the associated photomontages provide striking evidence of the adverse impact that the Bango Wind Farm will have from our residence. The visual impact is intolerable, and this will be exacerbated by the additional impacts from noise, resultant blade glint, shadow flicker and disturbance from any artificial night lighting.

The impacts will be significantly worse from one of our elevated rear lots where we intend to develop another residential dwelling for my parents.

An organisation such as yours should be adopting international best practice standards where placing turbines ten kilometres from any residence is the base condition. Australia is a vast country where numerous alternate opportunities present themselves both in-land and off-shore, as has been the practice in numerous other countries adopting such technologies.



This letter also serves as notice to your organisation of the high levels of stress you have already caused our family, and that amongst our adjoining neighbours.

Furthermore, whilst we acknowledge we authorised access for the noise monitoring to be conducted in good faith, we note that you gained access without permission in order to take your photos, and hereby insist that no further access is granted without authorisation (please note the property is monitored by video surveillance). Please also find attached the completed survey, which we have now been able to fill out as we have a clearer understanding of the project.

We confirm we reject your proposed "Wind Farm Neighbour Agreement" as this is not merely a financial consideration. Finally we will not support any application for development, permits, approvals, licences or consents your organisation seeks whilst turbines are within 10km radii of a residence.

We are in receipt of your letter dated 19<sup>th</sup> December 2012.

We note you have made modifications to the proposed layout of turbines originally provided to us with the photomontages, however we are still unequivocally opposed to the Bango Wind Farm proposal.

The remaining turbines are still far too close in proximity to our residence and adjoining residences and accordingly would completely devastate our amenity and well-being in both the eastern and western directions with the resultant visual impact, low frequency noise/infra-sound, blade flicker and glint.

Apology accepted for your acknowledged trespassing. We would also like to obtain the raw data from the noise monitoring conducted on our property for our records at your earliest convenience.

Finally we reiterate that we will not support any application for development, permits, approvals, licences or consents your organisation seeks with regards to the Bango Wind Farm proposal.
