

Project update

Work is ramping up at Clarke Creek Wind Farm and we look forward to keeping you updated on project construction progress.

Stage One of Clarke Creek Wind Farm achieved a major milestone recently with the successful installation of the first wind turbine. The turbine, which stands at 207 metres tall and has a capacity of 4.5MW, was built with 13 components including three 76.2m blades.

Another two turbines have now been fully erected with construction of six more well underway. We are also continuing work on site roads and hardstand areas.

We expect to have six fully erected turbines by December this year.

The project will help supply Queensland businesses with renewable electricity through a 15-year offtake agreement with Queensland Government-owned power company Stanwell Corporation.

Stanwell will take 346.5MW of renewable energy capacity from the 450MW wind farm to sell to commercial and industrial customers.

Clarke Creek Wind Farm Community Fund

Component deliveries

The 1,300 oversize overmass (OSOM) component deliveries are now underway from Gladstone Port, with deliveries taking place overnight with a police escort.
