Emergency Incident Response Procedure

Under Part 5.7 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997* (POEO Act), there is a duty to notify each relevant authority (identified below) of a pollution incident where material harm to the environment is caused or threatened. Material harm includes actual or potential harm to the health or safety of human beings or to ecosystems, that is not trivial or that results in actual or potential loss of property damage of an amount over \$10,000.

For any of the above pollution incidents, SQE staff shall immediately notify the relevant authorities as outlined below.
