# Year in review 2023



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Squadron Energy and CWP Renewables join forces, forming Australia's leading renewable energy company. We are 100% Australian owned with 1.1 gigawatts (GW) of renewable energy in operation and an Australian pipeline of 20GW.



**Spicers Creek Wind Farm** Environmental Impact Statement goes on public exhibition. The proposed project, located in the Central-West Orana Renewable Energy Zone, has an expected capacity of 700MW.



First turbine at **Clarke Creek Wind Farm** is erected. The 100-turbine 450MW Queensland wind farm will produce enough electricity to power 330,000 homes and avoid 738,000 tonnes of carbon emissions each year. The project is supporting 350 direct jobs and injecting \$110 million into the regional economy.

**Bango Wind Farm** opens in NSW, the first Australian wind farm to reach commercial operations in 2023. The 46-turbine site generates enough electricity to power 144,000 homes and avoids 543,000 tonnes of carbon emissions a year.
