

Project update

South West Renewable Energy Zone Access Rights Tender

Since April 2024, Squadron Energy has been participating in the highly competitive South West Renewable Energy Zone (REZ) access rights tender process. The tender was run by AEMO Services to determine which projects will receive rights to connect to the Project EnergyConnect (PEC) transmission line.

The result of the tender process was <u>announced on 23 April</u>. Unfortunately, the Gol Gol Renewable Energy Projects were not selected for connection access rights.

The indicative capacity available for the South West REZ was 3.98GW. AEMO Services highlighted the strong interest in the tender, receiving bids representing more than 15GW of generation and storage infrastructure. <u>View the press</u> release.

Next steps

Squadron Energy is continuing to develop the Gol Gol Renewable Energy Projects and is exploring other options and connection pathways.

Several possibilities are under investigation, including connecting to the existing 220kV transmission line. We are in regular discussions with Transgrid and EnergyCo and other key stakeholders to understand the opportunities for the future of the project and will keep the community informed as this progresses.

In the meantime, we are continuing project development activities and wind monitoring campaign. Over the coming months, we will continue to refine the project design based on wind data results and feedback from community engagement.
