Ilgingery Road update

Upgrade work has started on a section of Ilgingery Road, Wuuluman.

Tree clearing and pruning has been completed, and work is starting on the widening and upgrading of the existing culverts underneath the road. Ilgingery Road upgrade work is expected to be finished by the end of January 2025.

Project update

Since our last update in November, we have been making great progress. Service relocations (underground pipes and cables) for the Goolma Road and Twelve Mile Road upgrade are now on track for completion in early 2025.

Pre-construction minor works have started on the site access for the construction of temporary offices, as well as the switching station, substation and wind farm site facilities.

Twelve Mile Road upgrade

We are preparing to resurface the newly widened section of Twelve Mile Road and work is expected to start at the end of January 2025, weather and site conditions permitting.

Environmental update

The team recently helped to rescue a baby Magpie lark (*Grallina cyanoleuca*), which fell from a tree onto the busy main road due to high winds. The team was able to move the baby bird to safety, away from the traffic.

Recent warmer weather and spring showers meant that a Short-Beaked Echidna (*Tachyglossus aculeatus*) and an Eastern Long-Necked Turtle (*Chelodina longicollis*) needed some extra help from the team to cross the road.
